



## Academic Opening at ENSAE-CREST in Paris Assistant/Associate Professor in Economics

### Job Description

ENSAE calls for applications for the position of Assistant or Associate Professor in Economics, starting in September 2010.

Applicant profile:

- Applicants must have completed their PhD by September 2010
- Publications or strong potential of publications in academic journals of international standing
- Teaching experience

Knowledge of French is not required, however some knowledge of French is valued.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- To teach at Master's level (two 20-hour courses)
- To supervise student academic projects

- To participate in ENSAE's continuous effort to update its academic programs
- To participate in CREST's research activities (seminars, workshops, reading groups)

## Terms and application

Level of appointment and salary will be determined according to previous experience (up to approximately 70,000 euros per year net of social contributions, for candidates with a strong research record).

Tenure decision is made after 3 to 6 years.

- Three research papers
- Names of three academic references willing to provide letters of recommendation
- Any document attesting previous successful teaching experience
