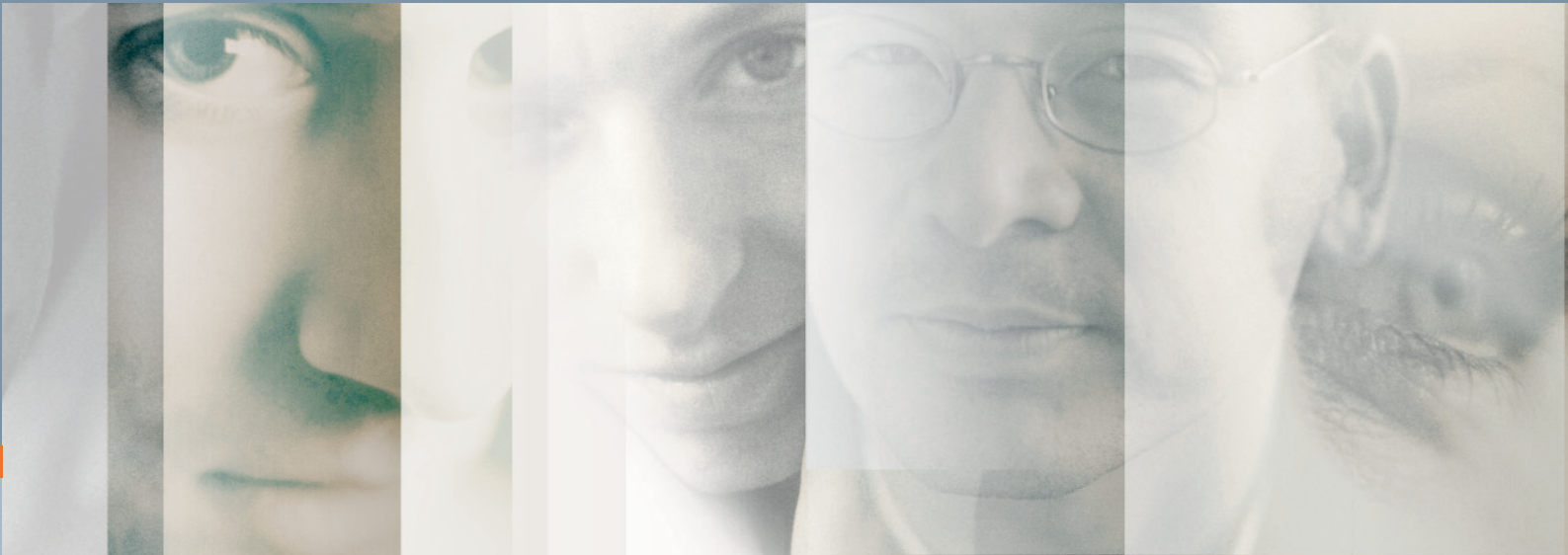

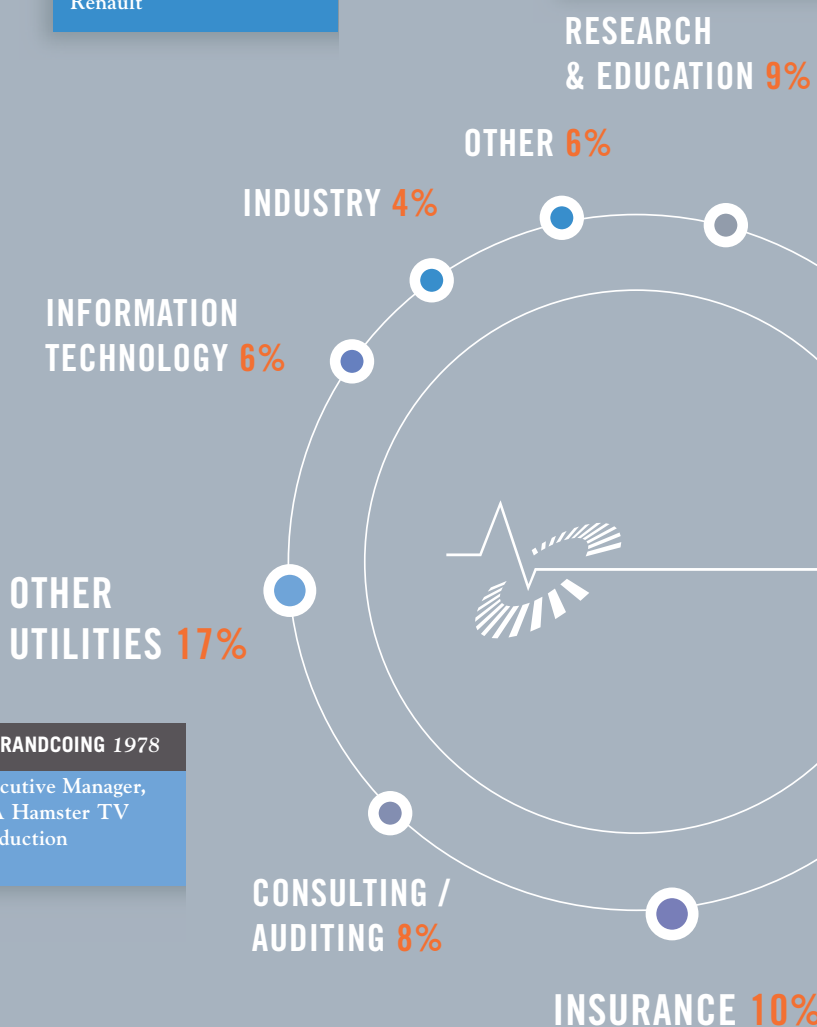

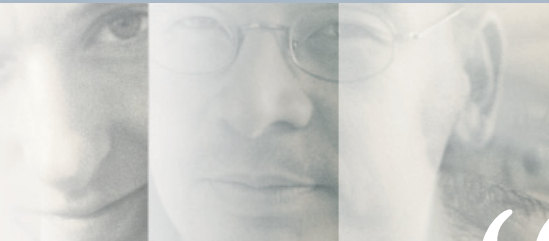
ENSAE graduates' medium gross wages rank **fourth** among French "Grandes Ecoles" and Universities. Graduates start at an annual median salary of **35/40k€** and reach **40/46k€** within 3 years.

 - Actuary and insurance: **11%**
 - Economics: **10%**
 - Financial analysis and auditing: **10%**

Most ENSAE graduates start their careers on R&D or consulting jobs in the following sectors: quantitative finance, asset management, actuary and insurance, economic analysis, statistics and research departments.



They reach positions of managing directors either in executive divisions (22% of ENSAE alumni are CEO), or in finance, management and legal branches (15%) or in R&D departments (14%).
